## Announcements

Hello Central,

As we return to worship “in person” this Sunday, we need to be sensitive to one another as everyone has a different level of comfortability with meeting again. Please abide by these social distancing guidelines to make sure we honor and respect all that attend.

**Guidelines:** Please...

- as always, stay home if you are sick or do not feel well.
- wear a mask if you desire.
- bring your own hand sanitizer.
- do not shake hands or physically embrace anyone- a smile and “hello” will do.
- maintain the social distance of 6 feet apart upon arrival to church and in the sanctuary.
- use the restroom at home before attending worship. The atrium restrooms will be open but need to be cleaned after each use.
- note the additional hand sanitizing stations in the sanctuary and atrium.
- know that the church basement and kitchen area will be closed.

**Sunday Morning:**

- Two services at **9:30** and **11:00 AM**.
- Services will be identical with the praise team singing both traditional hymns and contemporary songs.
- Chairs in the atrium will be set up for overflow if social distancing guidelines are compromised.
- There will be no children’s Sunday School, nursery, greeters, coffee, or bulletins.
- Offering plates will not be passed, but there will be collection boxes placed around the church. Please continue to give online or mail your offering to the church if you prefer.
- We will have a controlled, orderly dismissal after the worship services. The congregation will be asked to exit the building immediately following the dismissal.

These guidelines will be in place until further notice. Again, please be understanding and patient as these guidelines were implemented for the health and well-being of each person in attendance. **Live streaming of the service will continue at 9:30 AM.** If you are not comfortable attending in person, please worship with us in that way.
