Central Leadership Nomination Process (Ballots are on the back of the bulletin)

- 1) **September:** Each church member can nominate up to 6 other members to serve as an elder or deacon, or even nominate themselves if they desire.
- 2) **October:** All names that were nominated will be invited to attend one of two trainings held to discuss the elder and deacon roles at Central.
- 3) **November:**
 - a. October training attendees will be listed on the final nomination ballot. They also will choose the role in which they would like to serve: elder or deacon.
 - b. Church members will vote on the names listed on the final ballot. Three people with the highest total votes for both elder and deacon roles will serve on the consistory.
